

Admissions Information 2021–2022

Surval Montreux welcomes families to visit us and explore all that we offer.

We invite your daughter/ward (hereon referred to as your daughter) to join us for a Taster Day and Sleepover so that she can experience life in the School before proceeding with her application. If a visit is not possible, we will be happy to arrange a Skype meeting for you with our Principal, Mrs Woodhouse, who will be delighted to meet you and answer any questions you may have.

Having decided you would like to proceed in enrolling your daughter with Surval Montreux, next steps are:

APPLICATION

To apply for a place at Surval, please send us:

- Completed Application Form
- Application Fee: CHF 2'200.-
- A colour photocopy of your daughter's passport
- Copies of the last two years' reports from your daughter's current School
- Any report relating to special educational learning needs (e.g. dyslexia, dyspraxia) from an Educational Psychologist or similar professional

ENTRY ASSESSMENT: INTERVIEW AND ENTRANCE TESTING

On receipt of application, assessment papers will be sent to your daughter's School or to her agent for completion under supervision. Your daughter will then be invited to an interview with the Principal either in person or by Skype, whichever suits you best.

OFFER/ACCEPTANCE

If your daughter performs well in our entry assessments, we will confirm our offer of a place in writing. We will also send our *Joining Surval Montreux* pack with additional documents to be completed and returned to us.

To accept your daughter's place at Surval Montreux and qualify for the visa process, we must receive payment of the Acceptance Deposit (CHF 5'000.-). The Acceptance Deposit will be held in the School bank account and will be refunded **60 days** after the end of your daughter's final term at Surval Montreux, less any 'extras' for that final term, subject to no outstanding sums of money being owed to the School.

Please note this deposit is non-refundable in the event that your daughter does not take up a place previously accepted.

ADMISSIONS CONTRACT

The Contract between you (Parents/Legal Guardians [hereon referred to as parents]) and Surval will commence on formal acceptance of a place at Surval Montreux.

APPLICATION FEE

With the application, please submit proof of payment of CHF 2'200. This fee covers administrative costs and is not refundable under any circumstances.

ACCEPTANCE DEPOSIT

The Acceptance Deposit serves as a guarantee and will be refunded 60 days after the end of your daughter's final term at Surval Montreux, subject to no outstanding sums of money being owed to the School.

SKIING, SKI RENTAL AND SURVAL SKI WEEK (WINTER TERM ONLY)

This fee is compulsory to all students. It covers Ski Thursdays and Surval Ski Week mountain camp in January.

PERSONAL ACCOUNT AND PERSONAL EXPENSES

Your daughter's termly personal expenses and pocket money will be deducted from her Personal Account and statements will be sent to you at the end of each term.

Examples of Personal Expenses:

- Pocket money
- Dry cleaning
- Optional excursions within Switzerland
- Individual Sports Coaching offered in Surval's Enrichment programme
- Individual Academic or Music lessons CHF 200 per lesson
- Individual Special Educational Needs support lessons CHF 200 per lesson
- Swiss permit CHF 150
- Legalisation of diplomas and transcripts CHF 350
- Transfer to/from Geneva Airport CHF 360 one way
- Cooking package (trousers, jacket, shoes) CHF 120
- Medical expenses not covered by insurance e.g. dental treatment, COVID-19 test
- Optional Cultural trips (CHF 1'000 7'000 approx, subject to destination and duration)

Parents may be requested to transfer an additional CHF 5'000 if their daughter's Personal Account balance is low.

The final balance, if any, will be reimbursed 60 days after the end of your daughter's final term at Surval.

INSURANCE

Health and Accident Insurance is compulsory for anyone residing in Switzerland. All students at Surval are covered by the School's insurance policy, and this is charged to each student's account.

PAYMENT PLAN

Please note due dates for payments are as follows:

Autumn Term: 2 June 2021 Winter Term: 1 November 2021 Spring Term: 1 February 2022

All invoices must be paid in full. In case of late enrolment, fees are due upon receipt of the invoice. If fees are not paid by the due date, your daughter will not be able to attend classes, activities, examinations or Graduation until payment is received.

Reports, diplomas, recommendations or grade sheets will only be released once all financial obligations are settled.

Annual default interest of 10% is charged for any late payment, as well as a fee for issuing reminders (CHF 50 for second reminder, CHF 100 for additional reminders).

CANCELLATION AND NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

- Any termination of the contract must be notified in writing to the Principal.
- The Application Fee is not refundable.
- Notice Deadlines

Autumn Term: 7 May 2021 Winter Term: 7 October 2021 Spring Term: 7 January 2022

- If notice to cancel or withdraw is received before the Notice Deadline, the Acceptance Deposit will be retained.
- If notice to cancel or withdraw is received after the Notice Deadline, parents will be required to pay the Tuition and Boarding Fees for the following term.
- In case of expulsion, only the balance of the student's Personal Account will be refunded.

FORCE MAJEURE

Surval Montreux can suspend, or even stop, all services for reasons of force majeure such as major natural disasters, epidemics, war, terrorist attacks or any other similar circumstances affecting the operation of the School.

In case of force majeure, parents acknowledge that any limitation to the provision of services is not attributable to Surval Montreux, and there will be no fee reimbursement from the School.

SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

We want each girl to enjoy her time at Surval and take full advantage of all the exciting things we offer. Please remember we are all here to help and to ensure that your time here is a positive and enriching experience.

Surval's core values are centred around Honesty, Openness, Courage and Curiosity. Living here together is based on Courtesy, Consideration and Care for each other. Below are the principles we all live by:

- Surval does not tolerate bullying, harassment, racist language or other kinds of unacceptable behaviour.
- Students must assume responsibility for their personal safety. We do all that we can to create a safe environment for our students, but students must also play an active role in ensuring their own safety by being sensible, exercising caution and maintaining awareness of their surroundings.
- Surval does not tolerate any behaviour prejudicial to the health, safety or wellbeing of others or to the reputation of Surval
- Theft is not tolerated students must keep all valuable things in their personal safe.
- The possession and/or consumption of alcohol is forbidden unless a specific permission has been given. Alcohol tests may take place
- Surval is a non-smoking school. Smoking anywhere on the school campus or during trips/excursions is strictly forbidden
- The possession, trafficking and/or use of drugs either at school or off campus will result in automatic exclusion.
 Drug testing may take place.
- We reserve the right to inspect or search rooms and personal belongings at any time. We exercise this right in the event of suspected theft, tobacco, alcohol or drug use or other serious concerns. In these cases, students' electronic devices may also be searched.

Surval Montreux reserves the right to exclude students who do not follow this Code of Conduct.

Please note that the Swiss Law prohibits:

- The sale of tobacco to those under the age of 18
- The purchase and consumption of alcohol by those under the age of 16
- The consumption of alcoholic drinks other than wine and beer by those under the age of 18 (beer and wine are permitted from age of 16)
- The production, sale and consumption of all drugs
- Entry to bars, discothèques, games arcades and casinos for those under 16 unless accompanied by an adult
- Under 16s cannot be out unsupervised in the evening after 22.00

APPLICABLE LAW AND COMPETENT COURT

The General and Financial Conditions and all contractual agreements between the Parents and Surval Montreux are solely subject to Swiss Law, irrespective of where Parents may reside. Legal residence is elected in the Canton of Vaud, Switzerland and any dispute arising from the contract between the Parents and Surval Montreux will be submitted for decision to the local court of Montreux/Vevey.
